## **One Wisconsin Now Action Calls on Congressman Green to Apologize for Irresponsible Fear Mongering**

Milwaukee – One Wisconsin Now Action called on Congressman Mark Green to apologize for and retract a press release sent today from his taxpayer funded congressional office.

In the release, Green says, “News of the most recent terror plot, this one targeting the Mackinac Bridge, hits closer to home here in Wisconsin.”

Yet as has been widely reported, “The FBI said Monday it had no information to indicate that the three Texas men arrested with about 1,000 cell phones in their van had any connections to a known terrorist group.”

An FBI news release also said “there is no imminent threat to the bridge linking Michigan’s upper and lower peninsulas and that has no information indicating that the men have any direct link to a terrorist group.”

“Every step of the way, Mark Green has got it wrong on keeping our country safe and fighting the real threat of terrorism,” said John Kraus, Executive Director of One Wisconsin Now Action, “Today he got it wrong again and tried to use fear mongering tactics that he should be ashamed of.”
